Romans 13&14**

1. John 17:8 For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.
2. John 17:9 I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine.
3. John 17:10 And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them.
4. John 17:11 And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are.
5. John 17:12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.
6. John 17:13 And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.
7. John 17:14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
8. John 17:15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.
9. John 17:16-17 They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.
10. John 17:18 As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.
11. John 17:19 And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.
12. John 17:20 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;
13. John 17:21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.
14. John 17:22 And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:
15. John 17:23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.
16. 1 Corinthians 1:2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:
17. 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead:
18. 2 Corinthians 5:15 And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again.
19. 2 Corinthians 5:16 Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more.
20. 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
21. 1 Corinthians 6:11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.
22. Romans 8:31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?
23. Romans 8:32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?
24. Romans 8:33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.
25. Romans 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

1. Exodus 19:22 And let the priests also, which come near to the LORD, sanctify themselves, lest the LORD break forth upon them.
2. Leviticus 20:3 And I will set my face against that man, and will cut him off from among his people; because he hath given of his seed unto Molech, to defile my sanctuary, and to profane my holy name.
3. Leviticus 20:5 Then I will set my face against that man, and against his family, and will cut him off, and all that go a whoring after him, to commit whoredom with Molech, from among their people.
4. Leviticus 20:6 And the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits, and after wizards, to go a whoring after them, I will even set my face against that soul, and will cut him off from among his people.
5. Leviticus 20:7 Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye holy: for I am the LORD your God.
6. Leviticus 20:8 And ye shall keep my statutes, and do them: I am the LORD which sanctify you.
7. Joshua 7:13 Up, sanctify the people, and say, Sanctify yourselves against to morrow: for thus saith the LORD God of Israel, There is an accursed thing in the midst of thee, O Israel: thou canst not stand before thine enemies, until ye take away the accursed thing from among you.
8. Psalms 4:2 O ye sons of men, how long will ye turn my glory into shame? how long will ye love vanity, and seek after leasing? Selah.
9. Psalms 4:3 But know that the LORD hath set apart him that is godly for himself: the LORD will hear when I call unto him.
10. Psalms 4:4 Stand in awe, and sin not: commune with your own heart upon your bed, and be still. Selah.
11. Psalms 4:5 Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the LORD.
12. Acts 20:32 And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.
13. Acts 26:16 But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee;
14. Acts 26:17 Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee,
15. Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
16. 1 Corinthians 1:30-31 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.
17. 1 Thessalonians 4:3 For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication:
18. 1 Thessalonians 4:4 That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour;
19. 1 Thessalonians 5:22-23 Abstain from all appearance of evil. And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
20. 2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:
21. Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.
22. Hebrews 13:12 Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate.
23. 1 Peter 1:2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.
24. 1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:
25. Jude 1 Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called:

1. Exodus 9:13 And the LORD said unto Moses, Rise up early in the morning, and stand before Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD God of the Hebrews, Let my people go, that they may serve me.
2. Deuteronomy 8:19 And it shall be, if thou do at all forget the LORD thy God, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I testify against you this day that ye shall surely perish.
3. Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul,
4. Joshua 24:14 Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD.
5. Matthew 6:24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
6. John 12:25 He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.
7. John 12:26 If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour.
8. Romans 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.
9. Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.
10. Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
11. Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.
12. 1 Timothy 6:1 Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honour, that the name of God and his doctrine be not blasphemed.
13. 1 Timothy 6:2 And they that have believing masters, let them not despise them, because they are brethren; but rather do them service, because they are faithful and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort.
14. Hebrews 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.
15. Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)
16. Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:
17. Hebrews 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.
18. Galatians 5:13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.
19. Galatians 5:14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
20. Galatians 5:15 But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.
21. 1 Thessalonians 1:9 For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God;
22. Hebrews 9:9 Which was a figure for the time then present, in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience;
23. Psalms 101:6 Mine eyes shall be upon the faithful of the land, that they may dwell with me: he that walketh in a perfect way, he shall serve me.
24. Psalms 101:7 He that worketh deceit shall not dwell within my house: he that telleth lies shall not tarry in my sight.
25. Psalms 101:8 I will early destroy all the wicked of the land; that I may cut off all wicked doers from the city of the LORD.

Hebrews 12 &
Colossians 3**

1. Romans 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.
2. Romans 6:7 For he that is dead is freed from sin.
3. Romans 6:8 Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him:
4. Romans 6:9 Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him.
5. Romans 6:10 For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God.
6. Romans 6:11 Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.
7. Romans 6:12 Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.
8. Romans 6:13 Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.
9. Romans 6:14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.
10. Romans 6:15 What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.
11. Romans 6:16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?
12. Romans 6:17 But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.
13. Romans 6:18 Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.
14. Romans 6:19 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.
15. Romans 6:20 For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness.
16. Romans 6:21 What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death.
17. Romans 6:22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life.
18. Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
19. Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.
20. 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
21. 1 John 2:2 And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.
22. 1 John 2:3 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.
23. 1 John 2:4 He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
24. 1 John 2:5 But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.
25. 1 John 2:6 He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.

1. Psalms 6:9 The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer.
2. Psalms 28:1 Unto thee will I cry, O LORD my rock; be not silent to me: lest, if thou be silent to me, I become like them that go down into the pit.
3. Psalm 28:2 Hear the voice of my supplications, when I cry unto thee, when I lift up my hands toward thy holy oracle.
4. Psalms 31:21 Blessed be the LORD: for he hath shewed me his marvellous kindness in a strong city.
5. Psalms 31:22 For I said in my haste, I am cut off from before thine eyes: nevertheless thou heardest the voice of my supplications when I cried unto thee.
6. Psalms 31:23 O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.
7. Psalms 31:24 Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD.
8. Psalms 116:1 I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice and my supplications.
9. Psalms 116:2 Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live.
10. Psalms 119:169 Let my cry come near before thee, O LORD: give me understanding according to thy word.
11. Psalms 119:170 Let my supplication come before thee: deliver me according to thy word.
12. Psalms 140:6 I said unto the LORD, Thou art my God: hear the voice of my supplications, O LORD.
13. Psalms 143:1 Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my supplications: in thy faithfulness answer me, and in thy righteousness.
14. Jeremiah 3:21 A voice was heard upon the high places, weeping and supplications of the children of Israel: for they have perverted their way, and they have forgotten the LORD their God.
15. Jeremiah 36:7 It may be they will present their supplication before the LORD, and will return every one from his evil way: for great is the anger and the fury that the LORD hath pronounced against this people.
16. Acts 1:14 These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren.
17. Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
18. Philippians 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.
19. Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
20. 1 Timothy 2:1 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men;
21. 1 Timothy 2:2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
22. 1 Timothy 5:5 Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate, trusteth in God, and continueth in supplications and prayers night and day.
23. Hebrews 5:7 Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared;
24. Hebrews 5:8 Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered;
25. Hebrews 5:9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

1. Joshua 22:5 But take diligent heed to do the commandment and the law, which Moses the servant of the LORD charged you, to love the LORD your God, and to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and to cleave unto him, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul.
2. Proverbs 12:24 The hand of the diligent shall bear rule: but the slothful shall be under tribute.
3. Proverbs 15:28 The heart of the righteous studieth to answer: but the mouth of the wicked poureth out evil things.
4. Proverbs 22:29 Seest thou a man diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean men.
5. Proverbs 25:2 It is the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out a matter.
6. Ecclesiastes 1:13 And I gave my heart to seek and search out by wisdom concerning all things that are done under heaven: this sore travail hath God given to the sons of man to be exercised therewith.
7. Ecclesiastes 7:23 All this have I proved by wisdom: I said, I will be wise; but it was far from me.
8. Ecclesiastes 7:24 That which is far off, and exceeding deep, who can find it out?
9. Ecclesiastes 7:25 I applied mine heart to know, and to search, and to seek out wisdom, and the reason of things, and to know the wickedness of folly, even of foolishness and madness:
10. Jeremiah 29:13 And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.
11. Lamentations 3:40 Let us search and try our ways, and turn again to the LORD.
12. John 5:39 Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.
13. John 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;
14. John 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.
15. Acts 17:11 These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.
16. 2 Corinthians 8:22 And we have sent with them our brother, whom we have oftentimes proved diligent in many things, but now much more diligent, upon the great confidence which I have in you.
17. 1 Thessalonians 4:11 And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;
18. 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
19. 2 Timothy 2:16 But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness.
20. 2 Timothy 2:17 And their word will eat as doth a canker: of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus;
21. 2 Timothy 2:18 Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.
22. 2 Timothy 2:19 Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity.
23. 2 Peter 3:18 But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.
24. 1 John 2:21 I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but because ye know it, and that no lie is of the truth.
25. Revelation 1:3 Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

2. Psalms 33:2 Praise the LORD with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery and an instrument of ten strings.
3. Psalms 33:3-4 Sing unto him a new song; play skilfully with a loud noise. For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in truth.
4. Psalms 40:3 And he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the LORD.
5. Psalms 59:16 But I will sing of thy power; yea, I will sing aloud of thy mercy in the morning: for thou hast been my defence and refuge in the day of my trouble.
6. Psalms 59:17 Unto thee, O my strength, will I sing: for God is my defence, and the God of my mercy.
7. Psalms 96:1 O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth.
8. Psalms 96:2 Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; shew forth his salvation from day to day.
9. Psalms 96:3 Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people.
10. Psalms 96:4 For the LORD is great, and greatly to be praised: he is to be feared above all gods.
11. Psalms 98:1 O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory.
12. Psalms 98:2 The LORD hath made known his salvation: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen.
13. Psalms 98:3 He hath remembered his mercy and his truth toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.
14. Psalms 98:4-5 Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise. Sing unto the LORD with the harp; with the harp, and the voice of a psalm.
15. Psalms 144:9 I will sing a new song unto thee, O God: upon a psaltery and an instrument of ten strings will I sing praises unto thee.
16. Psalms 149:1 Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of saints.
17. Psalms 149:5 Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.
18. Psalms 149:6 Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a twoedged sword in their hand;
19. Isaiah 42:10 Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise from the end of the earth, ye that go down to the sea, and all that is therein; the isles, and the inhabitants thereof.
20. Isaiah 42:11 Let the wilderness and the cities thereof lift up their voice, the villages that Kedar doth inhabit: let the inhabitants of the rock sing, let them shout from the top of the mountains.
21. Isaiah 42:12 Let them give glory unto the LORD, and declare his praise in the islands.
22. Revelation 5:8 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints.
23. Revelation 5:9-10 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.
24. Hebrews 2:12 Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee.
25. Romans 15:9 And that the Gentiles might glorify God for his mercy; as it is written, For this cause I will confess to thee among the Gentiles, and sing unto thy name.
