Dress Code: We expect modesty to be observed by everyone. We want to encourage all of our youth to be modest.

All Gentlemen: dress clothes (a shirt with a collar, dress pants) preferably with a tie.

- No ear rings or inappropriate jewelry.
- No blue-jeans or shorts.
- No inappropriate advertising or printed t-shirts.

All Ladies: dresses or skirts that touch the floor when kneeling

- No slits that come up above the knee.
- No sleeveless or low cut tops.
- No shorts.
- Young ladies may change into culottes (clothing that looks like a skirt when one is in a standing position) after the service, and before scheduled activities.

Rally Participants: If you are participating in the quizzing, singing, or service activities, you must be dressed appropriately. In addition to the rules above:

- Gentlemen must wear ties when on the platform or helping with the offering.
- No t-shirts or tennis shoes on the platform.

We do not expect you to send visitors, which come with you, home for not dressing properly. However, we may make suggestions to help them modify their dress so as not to be a distraction to others. If you are unsure what is appropriate, please ask your Pastor or Youth Leader.

You may bring your cell phone, but it is only to be used for contacting your parents or in case of emergency. No headphones, please.
