

Dates and Times

- 1. Fundraising will officially begin May 7th, and run for two weeks.
- 2. For sponsorship funds to count toward the individual goal, they must be received on or before Sunday, May 21st.
- 3. Read-a-thon will begin at 1:00pm on Saturday, May 27th, 2023.

Sponsorship

- 1. For every \$10 pledged toward their individual goal, the camper receiving those funds will be responsible to read one chapter of the Bible, out loud, to those in attendance at the Read-a-thon.
- 2. Any amount of sponsorship is accepted, and will be tallied in \$10 increments.

Goals

- 1. \$240 Individual Goal
- 2. \$6,000 Team Goal additional funds will go toward camp costs, the MRBC youth fund, and a gift to BibleWay to cover extra camp expenses.

Awards

Individual Awards:

- a. For each additional \$50 raised toward the team goal, over the individual goal, the camper will receive \$5 to spend at the camp canteen.
- b. A 1st, 2nd, 3rd place prize will be awarded the top three campers raising the most funds

Team Award: If \$6000 goal is reached

a. MRBC Camp T-shirts for all campers.

Reading

- 1. All reading will take place from 1pm to approximately 5pm on Saturday May 27th, 2023.
- 2. There will be multiple readers, reading simultaneously at reading stations setup in and around the church. Total number of readers and chapters being read will determine the number of stations.
- 3. All readers will get a Bible Read-a-thon participation sticker.
- 4. Multiple reading stations will be placed throughout the church, and outside (weather permitting).
- 5. As much as possible reading slots and locations will be assigned ahead of time.
- 6. Chapters would be assigned by a "Reading Coordinator" upon arrival.
- 7. Chapters assigned/read will be tracked, and progress projected for all to view.
